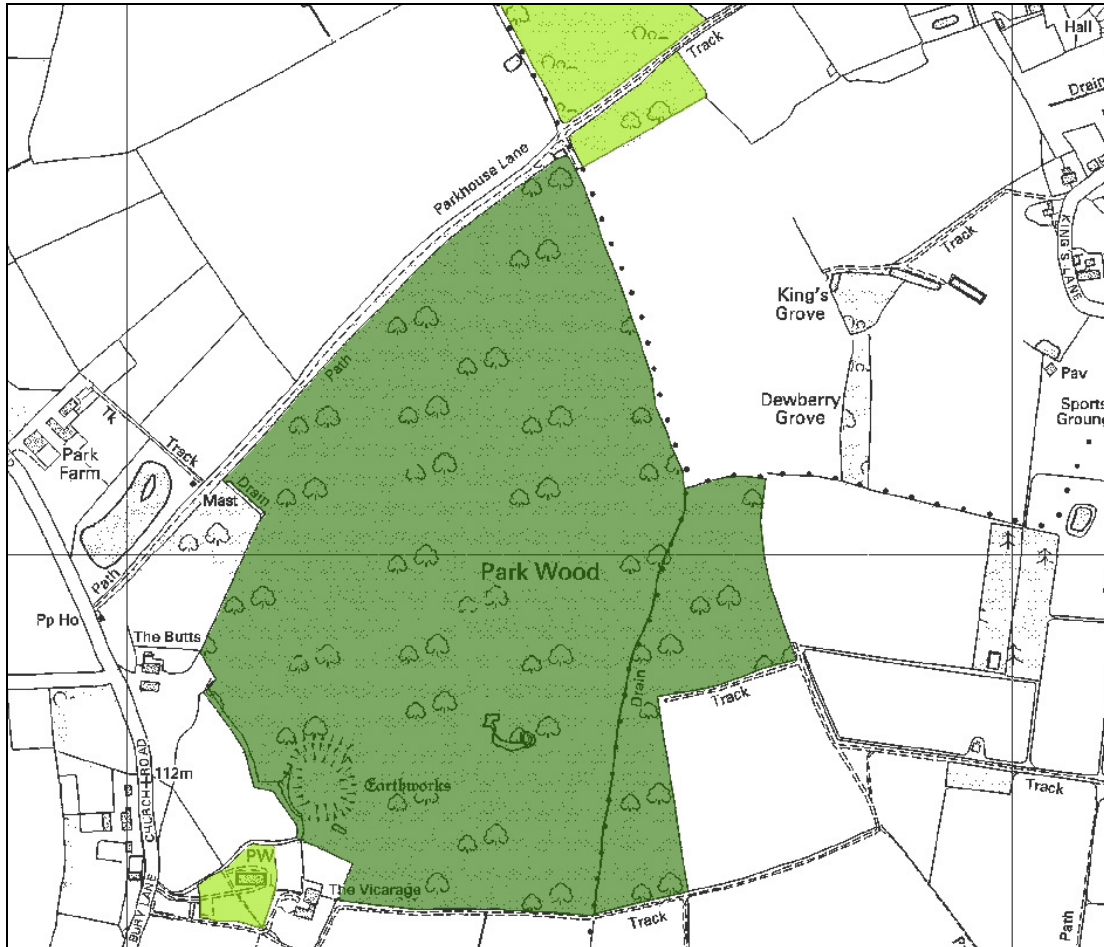

**Ufd10. Park Wood, Chrishall (36.4 ha) TL 455390**

Park Wood is dominated by coppiced Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) with standards of Ash and Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*). The generally open canopy structure results in a well-lit ground flora that is rich in ancient woodland plants such as Thin-spiked Wood Sedge (*Carex strigosa*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Yellow Archangel (*Lamium galeobdolon*), Hairy Wood-rush (*Luzula pilosa*), Early Purple Orchid (*Orchis mascula*) and Herb Paris (*Paris quadrifolia*).
