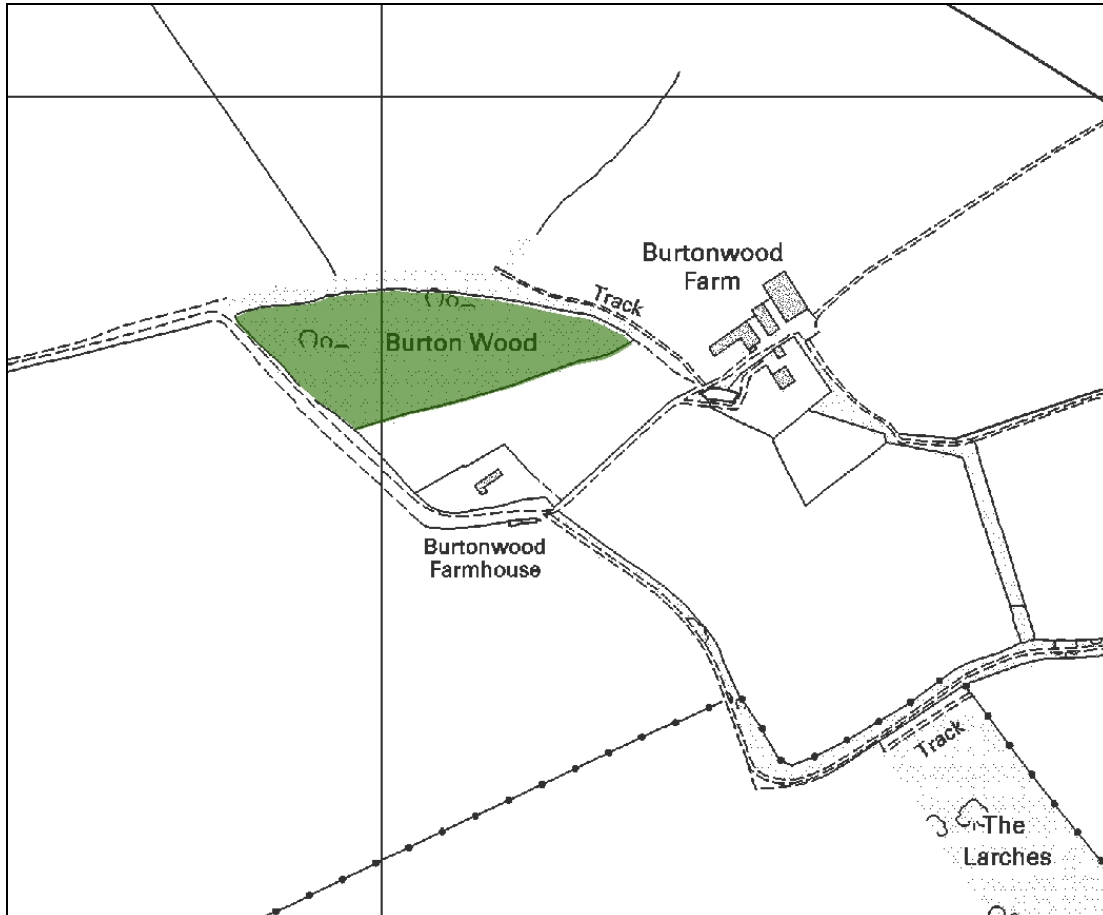


LOCAL WILDLIFE SITES.

Ufd103. Burton Wood



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Ufd103. Burton Wood (2.1 ha) TL 532438

This small ancient wood has a neglect coppice with standards structure of Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Field Maple (*Acer campestre*). The shrub layer includes Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*) and Spindle Tree (*Euonymus europaeus*). The ground vegetation is characterised by Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Wood False Brome (*Brachypodium sylvaticum*) and Ground Ivy (*Glechoma hederacea*).
