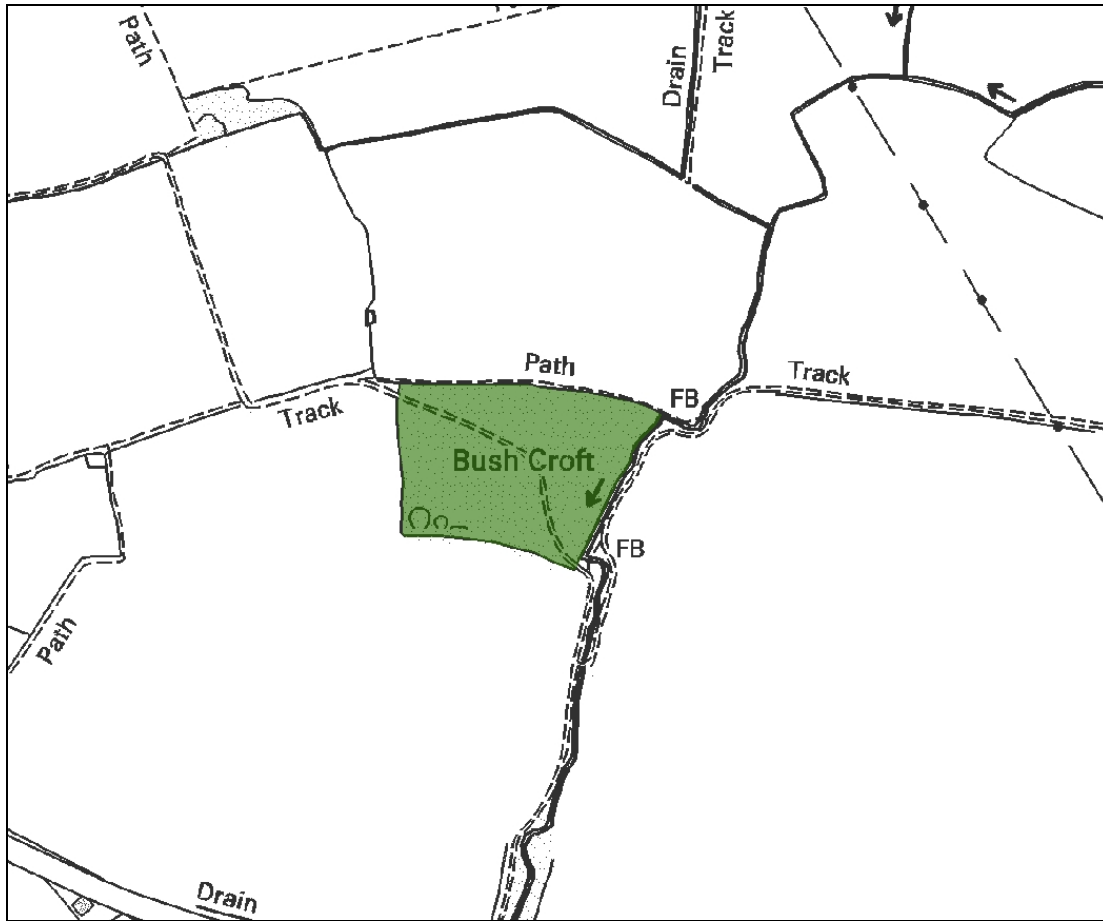

Ufd197. Bush Croft (1.8 ha) TL 595346

This small possibly ancient wood has a canopy of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*), Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Field Maple (*Acer campestre*), Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) and some Wild Cherry (*Prunus avium*). The understorey has abundant Hazel (*Corylus avellana*). The ground flora includes Sanicle (*Sanicula europaea*), Oxlip (*Primula elatior*), Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*), Ragged Robin (*Lychnis flos-cuculi*) and Goldilocks Buttercup (*Ranunculus auricomus*) amongst a typical assemblage of more common woodland plants.
