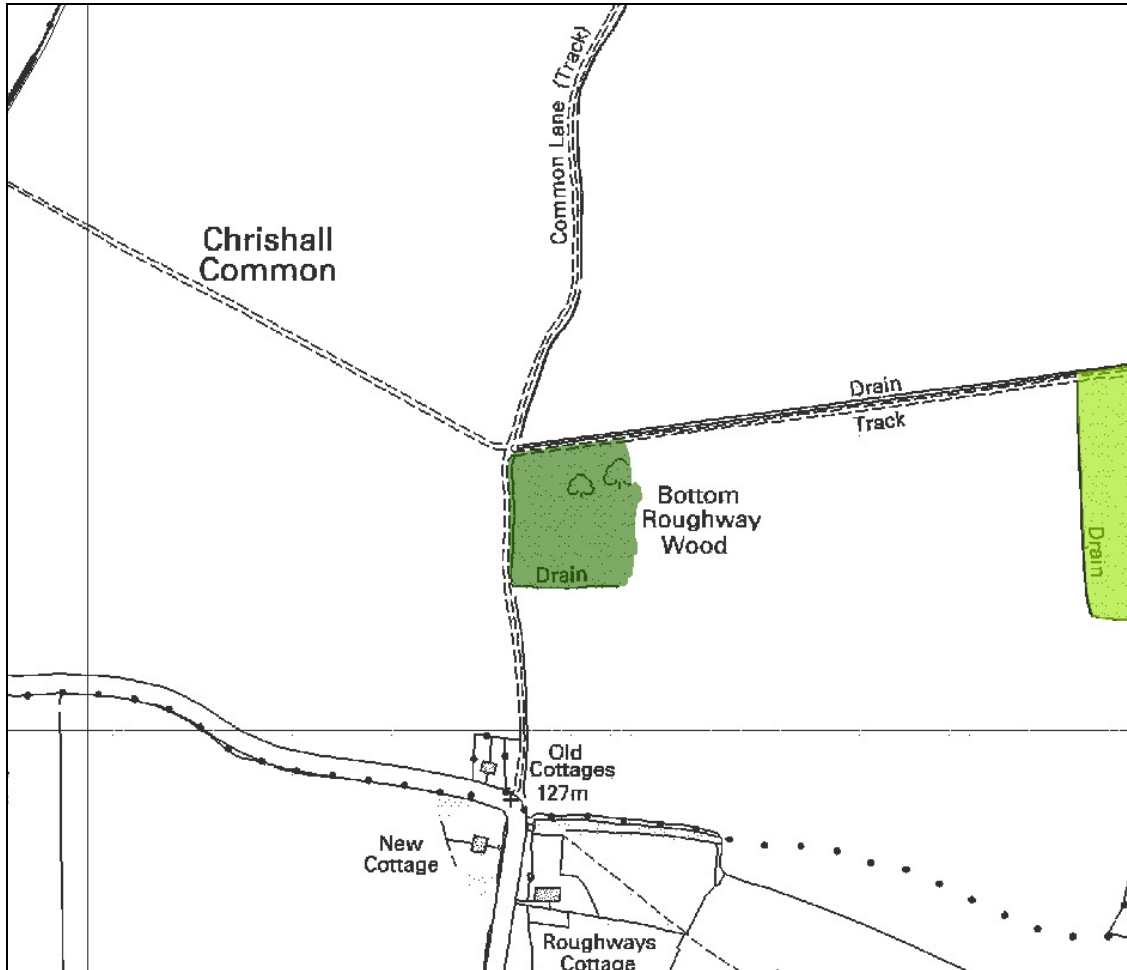

**Ufd2. Bottom Roughway Wood (1.2 ha) TL 434362**

This ancient wood fragment has a canopy of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) standards with Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) in the sub-canopy. Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Elder (*Sambucus nigra*) are the main shrubs, with some relatively recent coppicing of Hazel. The modest ground flora includes Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*) and Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*).
