**Ufd221. Bow Croft Wood (3.0 ha) TL 612332**

The canopy of this ancient wood is co-dominated by Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) and Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) over Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Elder (*Sambucus nigra*) with scattered Blackthorn (*Prunus spinosa*) and Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*). The ground flora is dominated by Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), but also includes Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) and Lesser Celandine (*Ranunculus ficaria*).
