**Ufd248. Great Sampford Road Bank (400.0 metres) TL 636362 to TL 639359**

This road bank supports a tall grassland community which is becoming increasingly scrub covered and in need of clearance and stable management. The chalk soil flora includes Greater Knapweed (*Centaurea scabiosa*), Knapweed Broomrape (*Orobanche elatior*), Glaucous Sedge (*Carex flacca*), Wild Basil (*Clinopodium vulgare*), Burnet Saxifrage (*Pimpinella saxifraga*) and Field Scabious (*Knautia arvensis*). These and other species attract a wide variety of butterflies and other insects.
