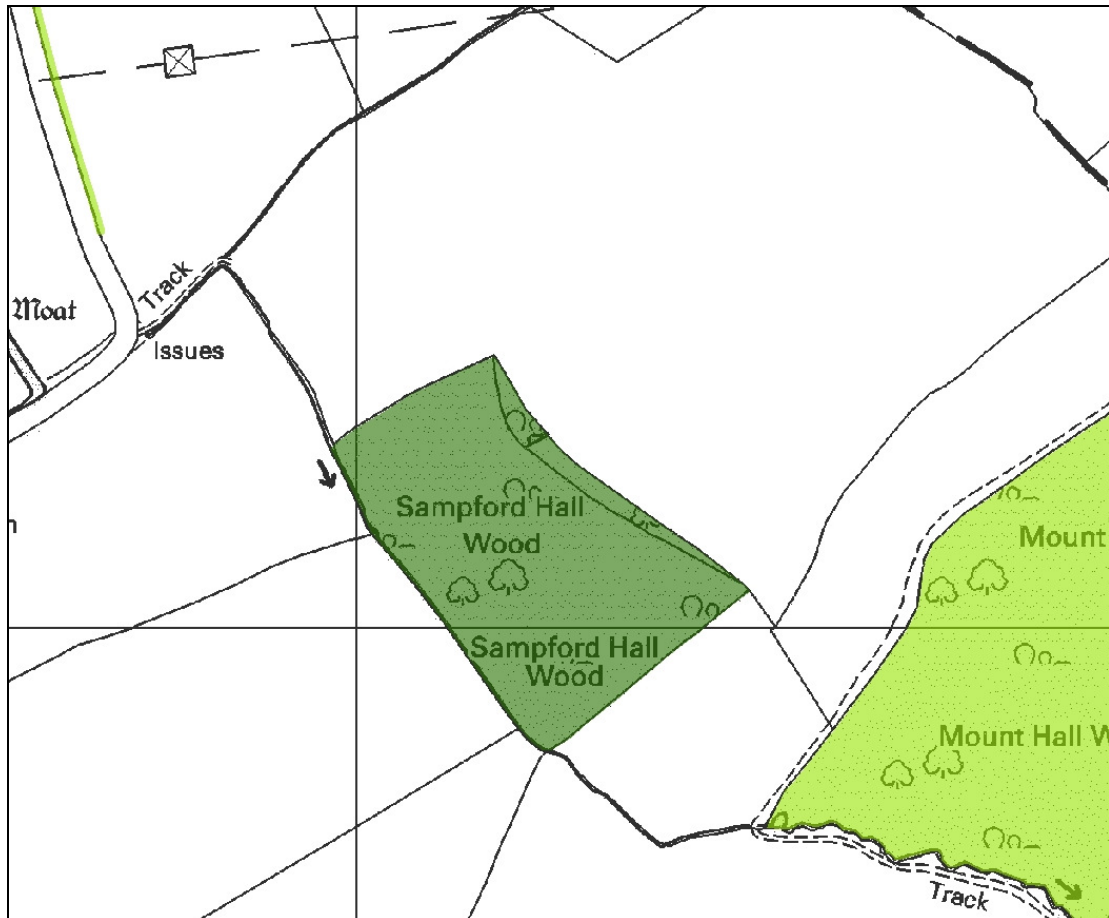

Ufd271. Sampford Hall Wood (3.6 ha) TL 661351

Mature Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) dominate the high canopy of this small wood. Much of this wood has been replanted with young Elm (*Ulmus* sp), Oak, Willow (*Salix* spp.), Wild Cherry (*Prunus avium*), Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and conifers. Wet tracks support a ground flora that includes Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*), Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*), Wood Sedge (*Carex sylvatica*) and Hairy St. John's-wort (*Hypericum hirsutum*).
