**Ufd38. Green Man Meadows (0.7 ha) TL 483343**

These two meadows support a varied flora. The sward is mainly composed of Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Yorkshire Fog (*Holcus lanatus*), Cock's-foot (*Dactylis glomerata*) and Bent-grasses (*Agrostis* spp.). Of interest amongst the herbs are Cowslip (*Primula veris*), Salad Burnet (*Sanguisorba minor*) and Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*), whilst Lady's Smock (*Cardamine pratensis*), Bee Orchid (*Ophrys apifera*) and Common Spotted Orchid (*Dactylorhiza fuchsii*) have also been reported.
