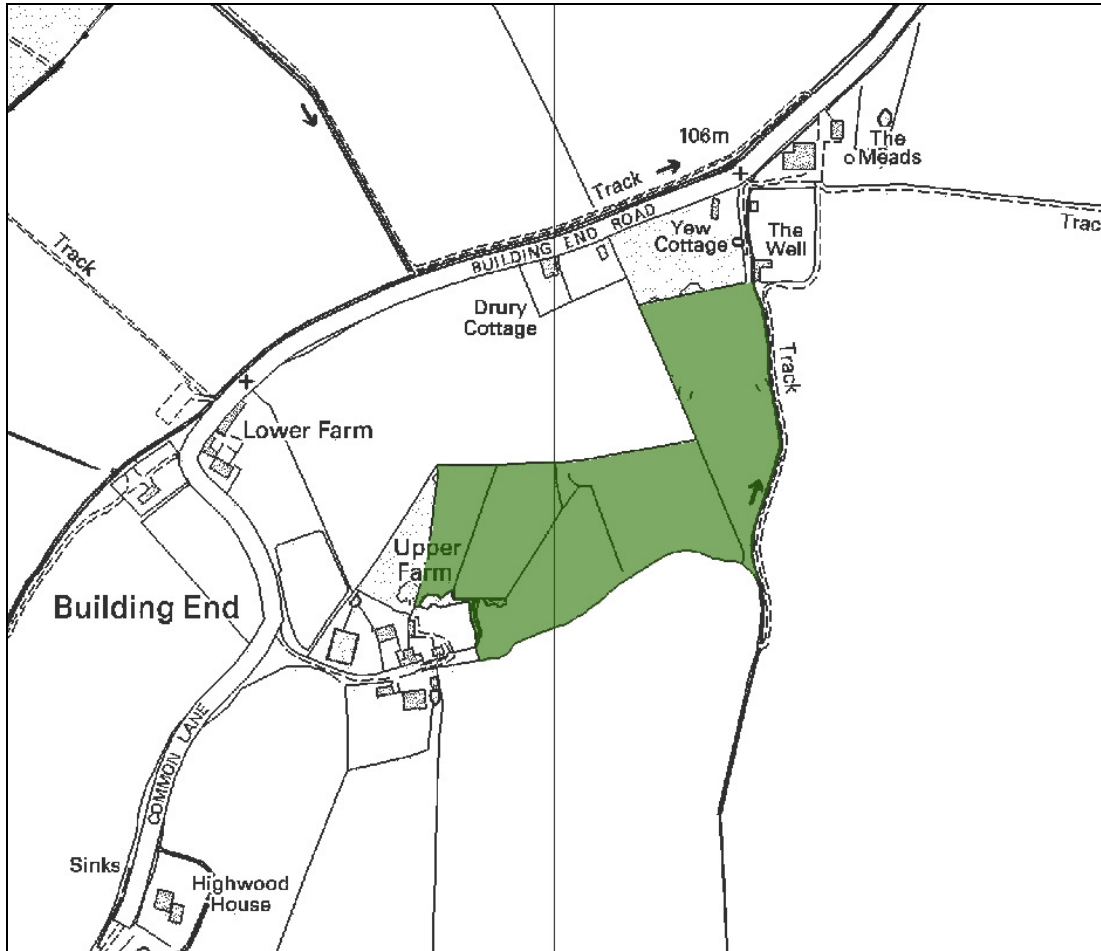

Ufd4. Building End Meadows (4.8 ha) TL 442376

This site comprises three old pastures, becoming increasingly scrub covered and bounded by thick hedges. The grassland flora is rich, including Salad Burnet (*Sanguisorba minor*), Common Spotted Orchid (*Dactylorhiza fuchsii*), Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*), Yellow-wort (*Blackstonia perfoliata*), Bee Orchid (*Ophrys apifera*) and Cowslip (*Primula veris*). These former pastures are in need of urgent management to clear invading scrub and cut or graze the sward in order to retain their valuable flora and value to invertebrates.
