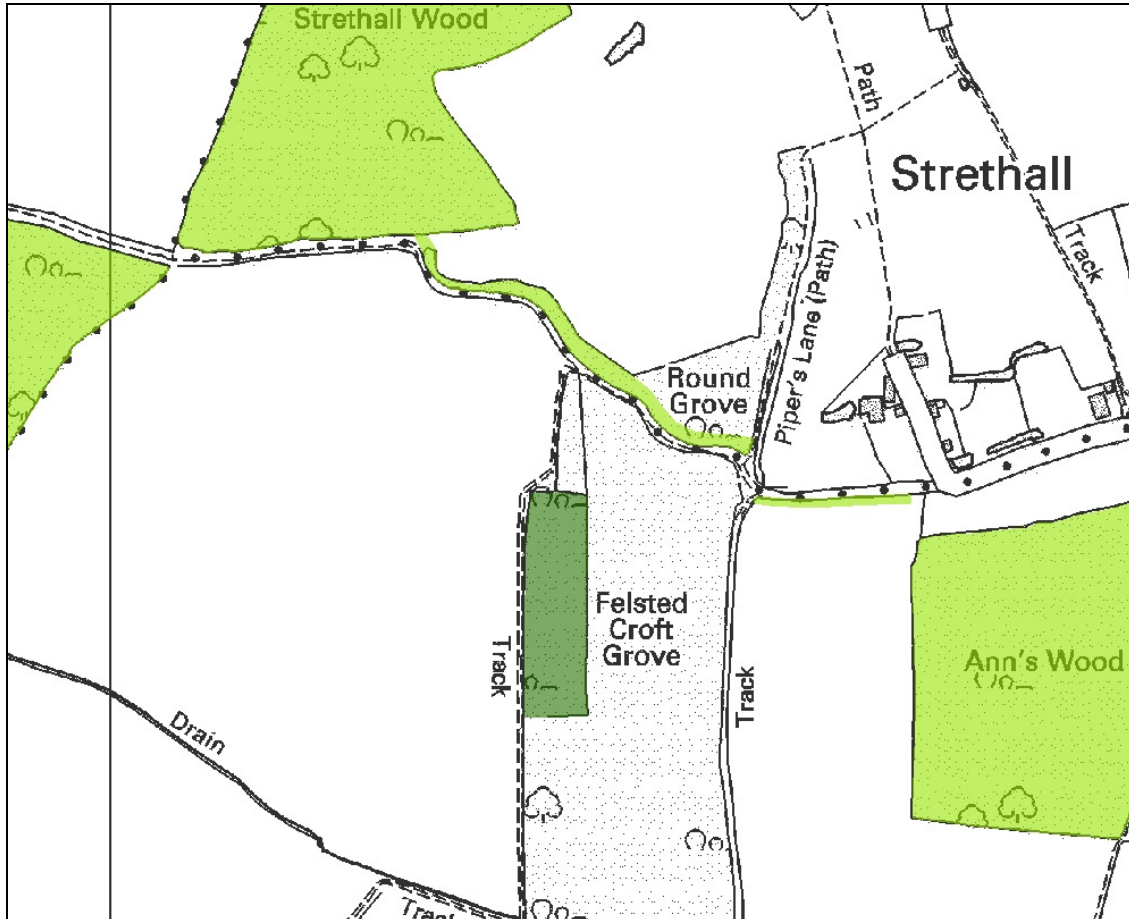

**Ufd40. Felsted Croft Grove (0.6 ha) TL 483394**

This small grove, which may well be at least part ancient, has a canopy dominated by Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*). Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) dominates the understorey, with lesser amounts of Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) and Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*). The ground flora is typified by abundant Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) and Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), with Marsh Thistle (*Cirsium palustre*), Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*), Wood Millet (*Milium effusum*) and Goldilocks Buttercup (*Ranunculus auricomus*) also present.
