**Ufd7. High Wood (49.6 ha) TL 450365**

Although extensively replanted with conifers and very actively managed as a productive plantation, this large ancient woodland site still retains significant conservation value. The numerous rides support a marshy grassland flora that includes Ragged Robin (*Lychnis flos-cuculi*), Common Spotted Orchid (*Dactylorhiza fuchsii*), Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Pendulous Sedge (*Carex pendula*) and various Rushes (*Juncus* sp.) and Sedges (*Carex* sp.). Orpine (*Sedum telephium*) has also been recorded. The site would be considerably enhanced by the preferential use of native broadleaved species as part of the forestry operations.
