**Ufd86. Woodside Green (23.7 ha) TL 522182**

This site is one of the largest extents of common land with semi-natural vegetation in Essex. Although the main sward has been extensively improved for grazing in the past, the current management strategy is aimed towards reducing this. The green is much used by foraging badgers from the adjacent woods. Included within this site are a series of ponds along the western boundary and marshy grassland to the north - east. Round-fruited Rush (*Juncus compressus*), a scarce Essex plant, has been recorded from one of these ponds.
