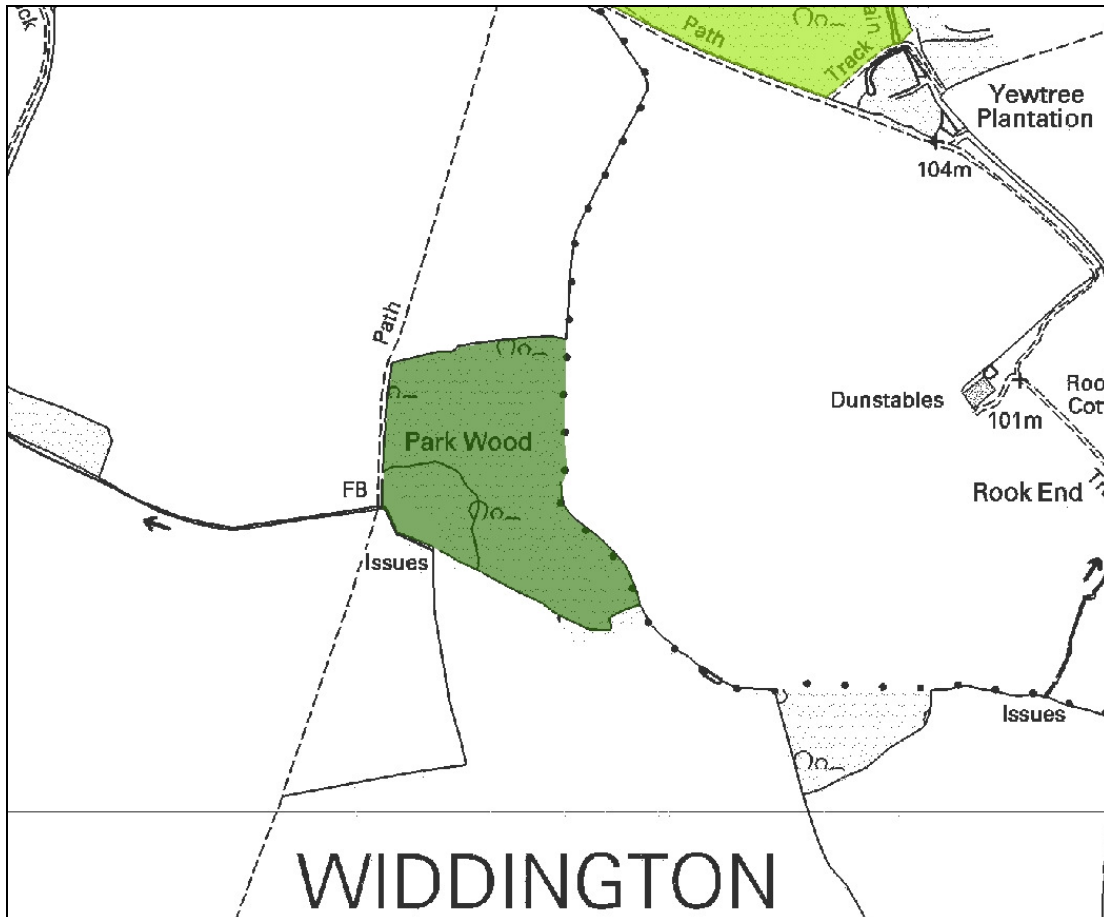

Ufd114. Park Wood, Widdington (2.9 ha) TL 543323

The composition of this wood is mainly Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) coppice with interspersed Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) standards. Some Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) coppice is found as an understorey, whilst Blackthorn (*Prunus spinosa*), Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*) and Elder (*Sambucus nigra*) form the shrub layer and includes Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*). The ground flora is dominated by Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*) with Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus*) and Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*) in patches throughout.
