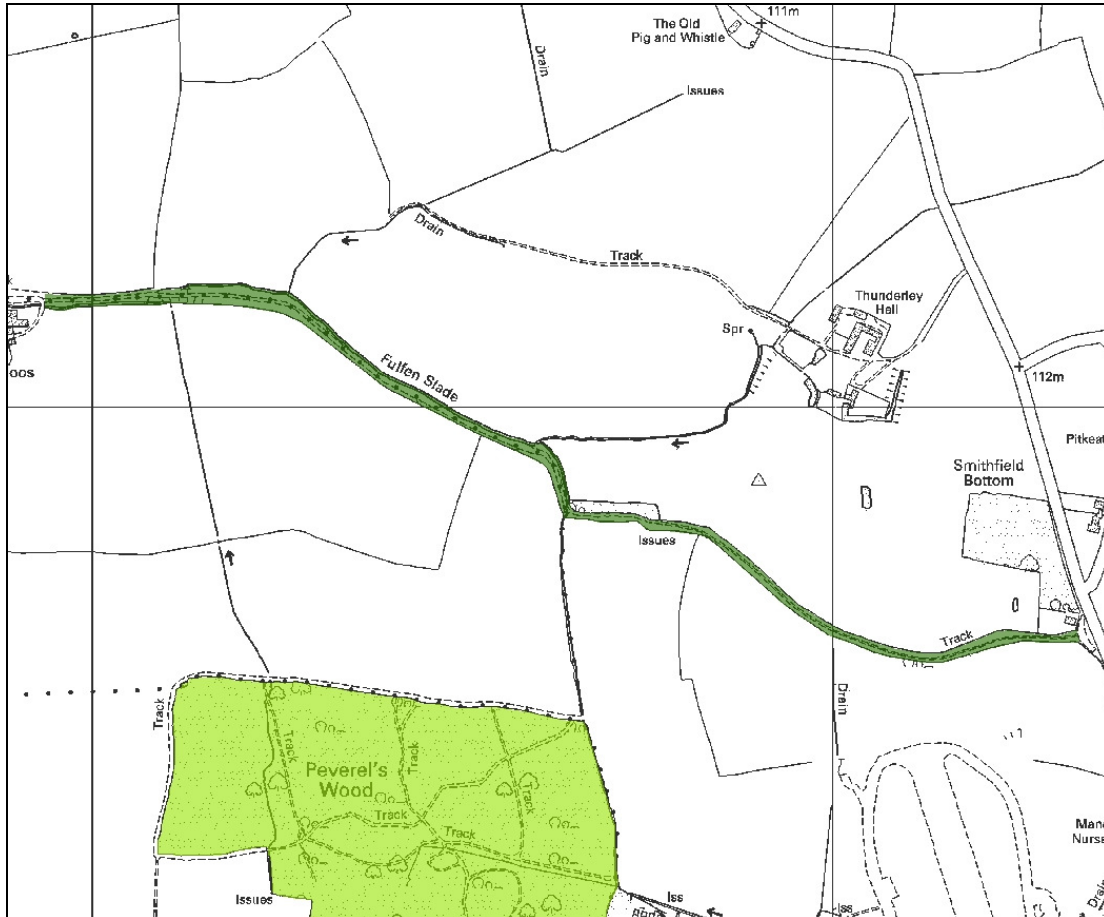

**Ufd129. Fulfen Slade Lane (1500.0 metres) TL 555360**

This ancient lane supports a varied woodland and grassland flora. The hedges are typically composed of Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*), Dogwood (*Cornus sanguinea*), Blackthorn (*Prunus spinosa*), Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Elm (*Ulmus* sp.), with lesser amounts of Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*), Spindle Tree (*Euonymus europaeus*) and Wayfaring Tree (*Viburnum lantana*).
