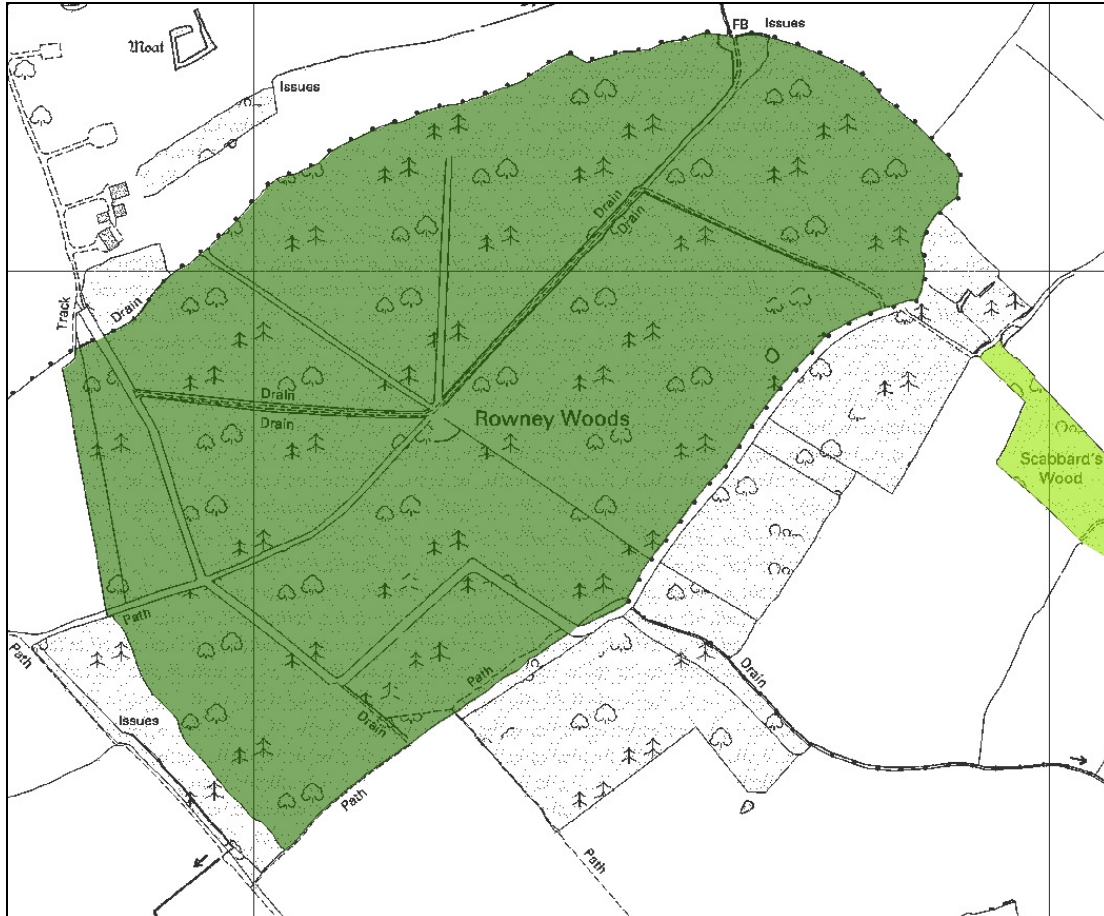

This large ancient wood has been extensively replanted with blocks of Norway Spruce, Red Cedar and Scots Pine, with scattered standards of mainly Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*). Floristically, most diversity occurs along the wood rides and includes Oxlip (*Primula elatior*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*) and Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*).
