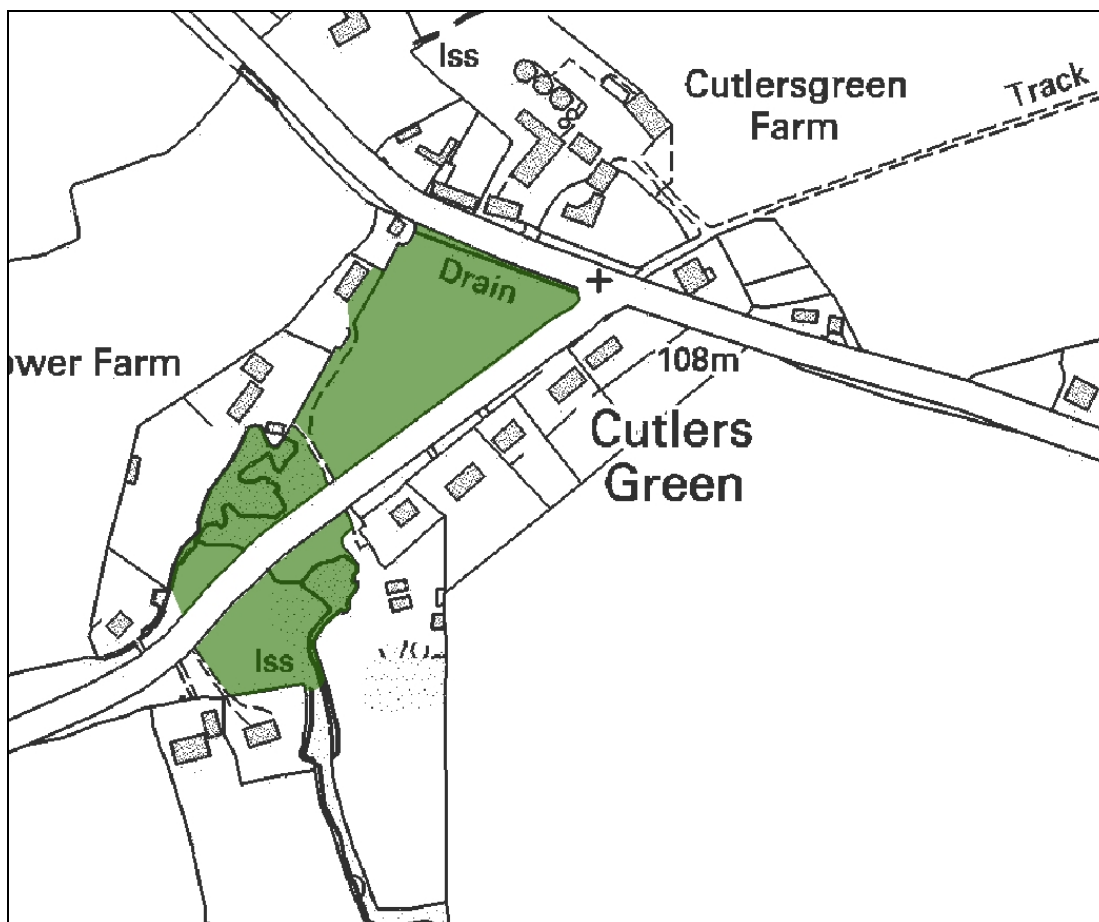

Ufd198. Cutlers Green (EWT Nature Conservation Area) (1.7 ha) TL 596307

This green, with ponds, displays a wide variety of grasses including Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*), Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Yorkshire Fog (*Holcus lanatus*) and Yellow Oat-grass (*Trisetum flavescens*). Among the other flora present are Cowslip (*Primula veris*), Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*), Lady's Smock (*Cardamine pratensis*), Common Spotted Orchid (*Dactylorhiza fuchsii*), Field Wood-rush (*Luzula campestris*), Creeping Jenny (*Lysimachia nummularia*) and Burnet Saxifrage (*Pimpinella saxifraga*). Two ponds are also present.
