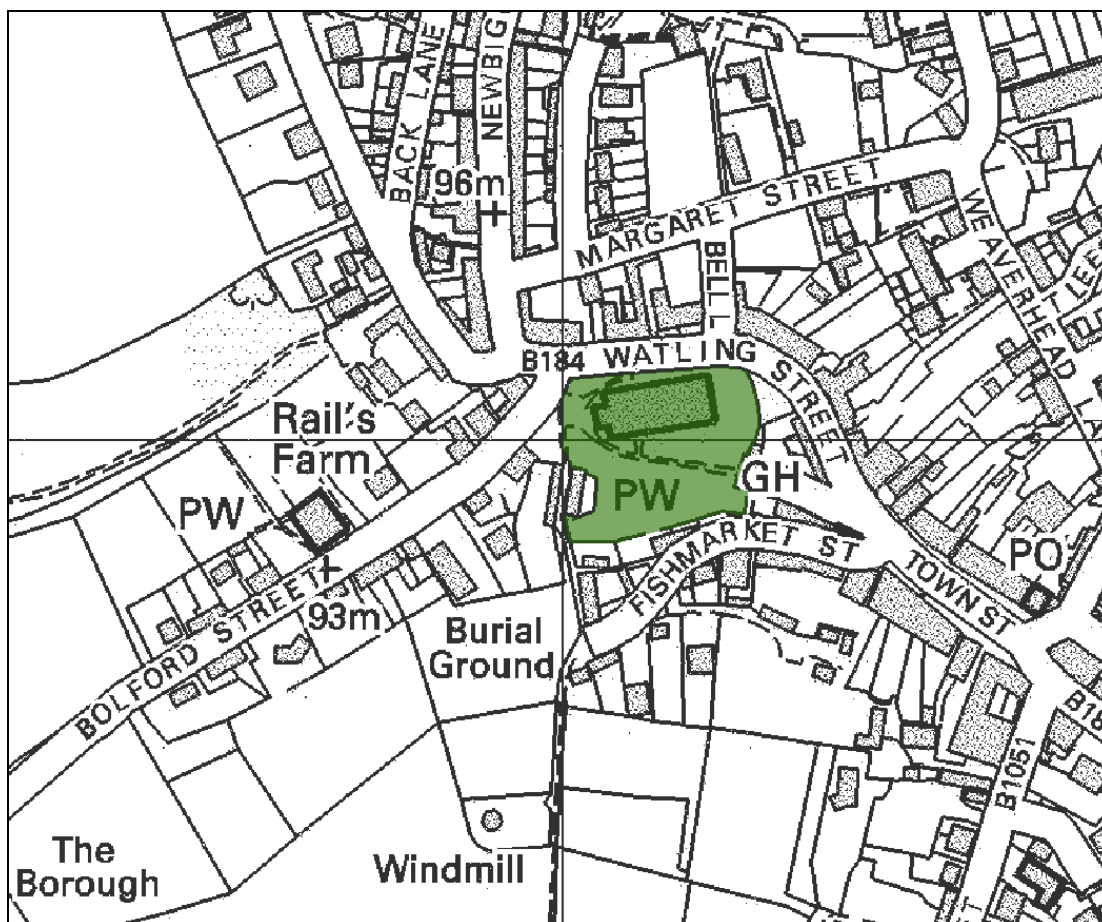

Ufd220. Thaxted Churchyard (0.6 ha) TL 610310

This yard has preserved an ancient piece of grassland. Of note amongst the flora is Polypody Fern (*Polypodium vulgare*) growing on the church walls, whilst Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*), Lady's Smock (*Cardamine pratensis*) and Common Milkwort (*Polygala vulgaris*) (a rare plant in Essex) have been recorded from the grassland.
