Ufd225. Cowless Hall Meadows (3.1 ha) TL 613381

This site comprises two long, narrow grasslands either side of a small stream. The soil conditions vary from well drained through to wet and marshy conditions and this results in a varied flora which includes Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Sharp-flowered Rush (*Juncus acutiflorus*), Glaucous Sedge (*Carex flacca*), Field Wood-rush (*Luzula campestris*), Hoary Plantain (*Plantago media*), Cowslip (*Primula veris*) and Bulbous Buttercup (*Ranunculus bulbosus*). The main grasses present are Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*), Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Creeping Bent-grass (*Agrostis stolonifera*) and Cock's-foot (*Dactylis glomerata*).
