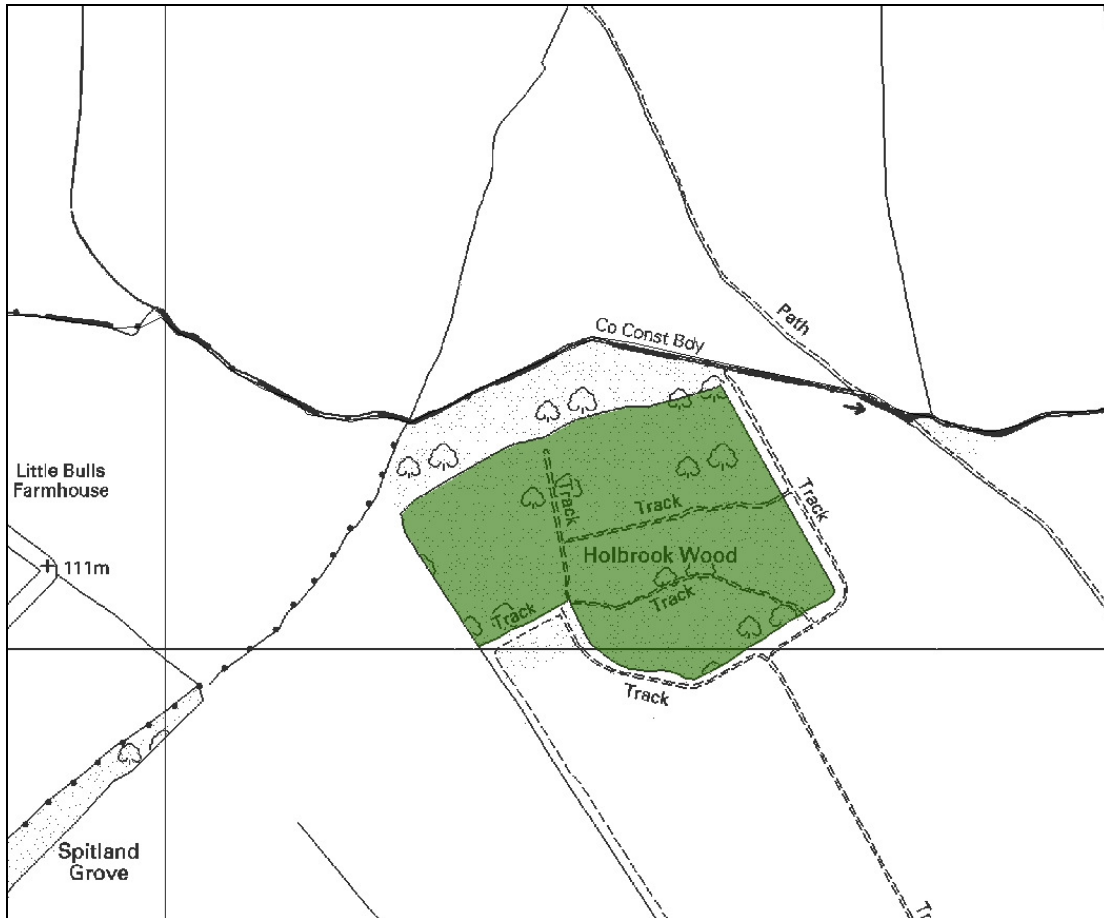

Ufd247. Holbrook Wood (7.0 ha) TL 634402

This ancient wood comprises old coppiced Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) and Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) with standards of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*). The shrub layer includes Spindle Tree (*Euonymus europaeus*) and Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*). The ground flora is rich and includes Hairy St. John's-wort (*Hypericum hirsutum*), Wood Millet (*Milium effusum*), Three-veined Sandwort (*Moehringia trinervia*), Early Purple Orchid (*Orchis mascula*), Herb Paris (*Paris quadrifolia*) and Oxlip (*Primula elatior*).
