Ufd273. Great Howe Wood (6.1 ha) TL 664341

The section of Great Howe Wood in Uttlesford District comprises coppiced Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*), Hornbeam (*Carpinus betulus*) and Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) with standards of Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*). Spindle Tree (*Euonymus europaeus*) and Midland Hawthorn (*Crataegus laevigata*) are found in the shrub layer. Species of the ground flora include Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Primrose (*Primula vulgaris*) and Hairy St. John's-wort (*Hypericum hirsutum*).
