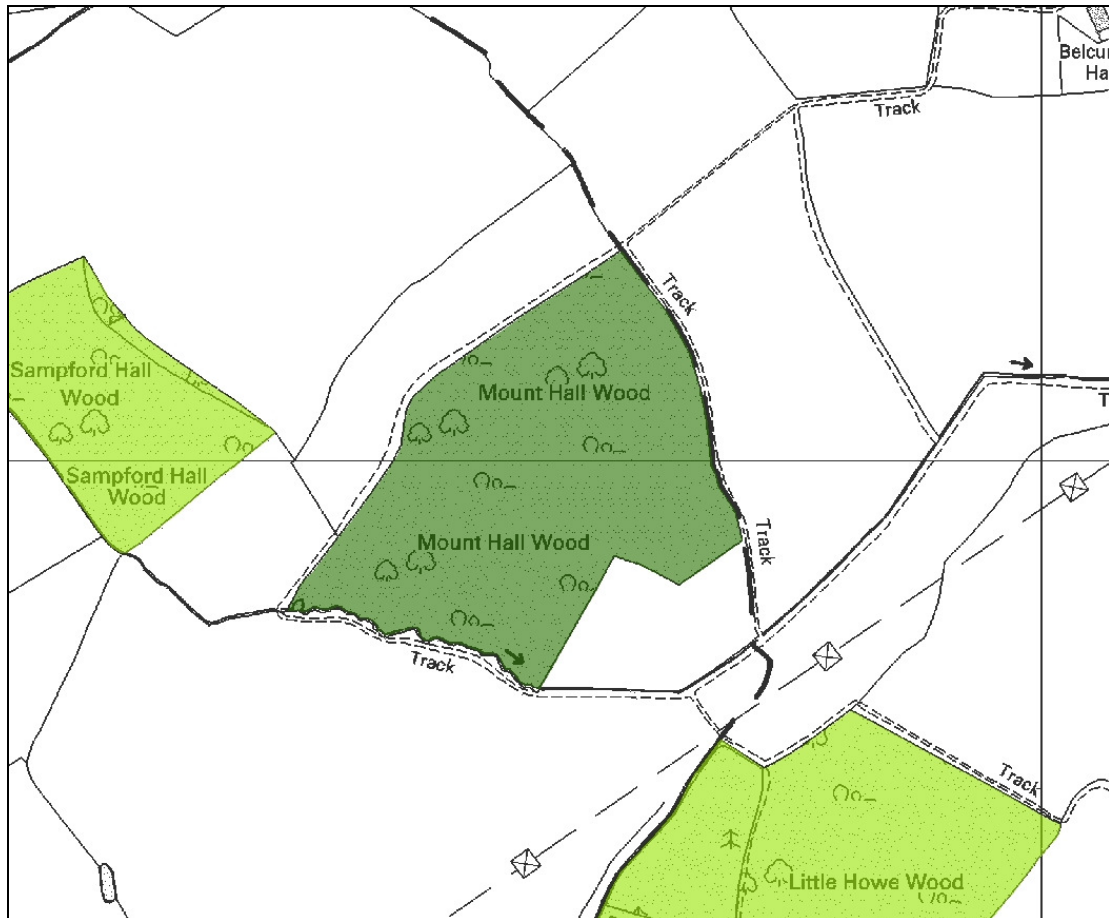

Ufd274. Mount Hall Wood (9.3 ha) TL 666350

This ancient wood comprises old Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) coppice, some Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) coppice and Ash and Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) standards. Hazel (*Corylus avellana*), Elm (*Ulmus* sp.) and young Ash and Field Maple are found in the shrub layer, which also includes Spindle Tree (*Euonymus europaeus*). The ground flora mainly consists of scattered Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus*) and Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*). Other ground flora species include Hairy St. John's-wort (*Hypericum hirsutum*) and Wood Sedge (*Carex sylvatica*).
