Ufd34. Lee Wood (South) (4.7 ha) TL 481383

This block of ancient wood comprises Pedunculate Oak (*Quercus robur*) and Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) with Ash, Hazel (*Corylus avellana*) and Field Maple (*Acer campestre*) coppice. Rides, clearings and areas of dense scrub are managed for game rearing. The wet soil conditions give rise to a marshy ground flora characterised by Rushes (*Juncus* spp.), Sedges (*Carex* spp.), Meadowsweet (*Filipendula ulmaria*), Dog's Mercury (*Mercurialis perennis*), Bluebell (*Hyacinthoides non-scripta*), Wood Anemone (*Anemone nemorosa*) and Tufted Hair-grass (*Deschampsia cespitosa*).
