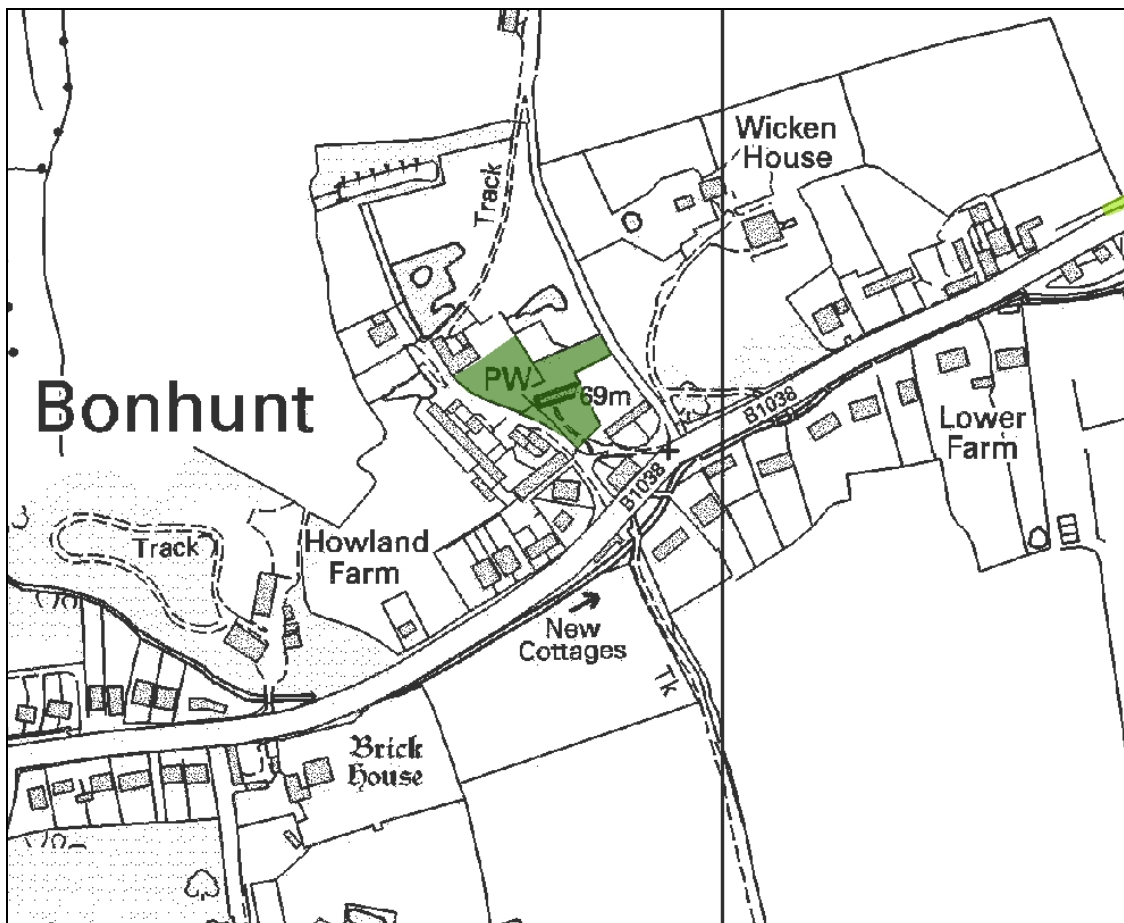

**Ufd60. Wicken Bonhunt Churchyard (0.4 ha) TL 499333**

This small churchyard supports good chalky clay grassland. The sward comprises Meadow Foxtail (*Alopecurus pratensis*), Cock's-foot (*Dactylis glomerata*), Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Sweet Vernal Grass (*Anthoxanthum odoratum*), Yorkshire Fog (*Holcus lanatus*) and Rough Meadow-grass (*Poa trivialis*) along with the scarce Downy Oat-grass (*Helictotrichon pubescens*). Typical herbs include Hoary Plantain (*Plantago media*), Lady's Bedstraw (*Galium verum*), Nettle-leaved Bellflower (*Campanula trachelium*), Stinking Iris (*Iris foetidissima*), Lady's Smock (*Cardamine pratensis*) and Ox-eye Daisy (*Leucanthemum vulgare*).
